

POLICY FOR PLACING REFUSE CONTAINERS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

All containers requested by private residents will be placed on street surface only. In the event the street is not wide enough to permit traffic passage, container will be placed on most convenient Borough right-or-way.

To prevent damages to sidewalks, yards, driveways, wire service drops, underground water, sewer, gas lines, etc. No refuse container will be placed on private property areas (including driveways) unless the property owner accepts all responsibility for damages that may occur in the placing of said containers. It is understood that "Damages" pertains not only to the above-mentioned articles, but any type private property, which may be damaged by privately placing containers.

The following items are NOT allowed to be placed in borough containers. Tires, electronics, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, microwaves, refrigerators, compost materials, etc.

Container rates are based on a minimum of one dump per month.

Please Note: If container is not dumped on a monthly basis there will be a \$40.00 per month rental fee for an unused container.

Once the container is placed it is not to be moved by anyone other than the refuse crew.

Containers are only to be filled level to the top of the container.
